1728 - 1779

THOMAS BAKER, 3 Oct. 1751 - 10 Oct. 1752; 1,196 a. (of which 82 a. are surplus & 405 are waste and ungranted); on brs. of Rush R. on both sides of Baker's two pat<sup>s</sup> dated June 1749 & on the S. side of Delamore or Kennerleys Mt. near Cool Spring on the S. side of an arm of Peaked Mt.; adj. James Kennerley, Henry Tyler, Francis Tyler. CC - Henry Gambril, Sen<sup>r</sup> & Henry Gambril, Jun<sup>r</sup>. Surv. John Mauzy.

THOMAS BALLARD, assignee of Micajah Poole; no war<sup>t</sup>, date from survey - 30 Sept. 1749 - surv<sup>d</sup> for Poole 2 Dec. 1749; 265 a. on Guard vine fork, on S. side of White Wallnut Mt. & David's Mt.; adj. the Rev<sup>d</sup> M<sup>r</sup> John Thompson, John Chizam. CC - Gerrard Manyfield, John McKenzie. Surv. Philip Clayton.

ADAM BANKS, 3 Feb. 1778 - 8 Feb. 1778; 34 a. on Rapidan R. in war<sup>t</sup> & Stanton R. in survey; adj. William Stanton, Isaac Smith. CC - Will. Smith & Isaac Smith. Surv. George Hume.

AMBROSE BARNETT, 8 Mar. 1750 - 17 July 1750; 1,646 a.; Barnett wishes the waste land surv<sup>d</sup> within the pat. formerly granted to his father, John Barnett, dec<sup>d</sup> & William Phillips for 1,100 a. as surv<sup>d</sup> in 1735, part of this land was conveyed by the patentees to John Booten & by him sold in Oct. 1749 to Jno Barnett; on Beverdam Run & "Beautiful alias Smiths Run;" adj. Zachary Gibbs, John Medley, John Buford, Joseph Rogers, dec<sup>d</sup>, James Barbour, the Hon<sup>ble</sup> John Grymes, Esq., dec<sup>d</sup>, W<sup>m</sup> Gibbons (formerly the said John Barnett's); no CC shown. Surv. Philip Clayton.

*← died intestate land regranted to Maj Wm Roberts 9 Oct 1779 by the Lord Proprietor*  
 JOHN BARRAGALL of Orange, 9 Dec. 1747 - 14 Jan. 1747/48; 400 a. on Cannen's R. near mouth of Rush R. at foot of Red Oak Mt. on side of Thornton's R., commonly called the Cannon R. where he lives. CC - William Duncan, Sen<sup>r</sup> & William Duncan, Jun<sup>r</sup>. Surv. John Baylis. "Rock Mill Area today"

From verso of survey - "John Barragall being Represented as an object of Charity his Lordship has directed that this Land shall not be forfeited for not taking out the Deed within the time limited by an Advertisement." (Signed) B. Martin.

EDMOND BASIE, JUN<sup>R</sup>, assignee of Edmond Browning; 30 Nov. 1751 - 3 Nov. 1752, both in name of Browning; 157 a. on the Little Fork of Rappa R.; adj. Tho<sup>s</sup> Corbin, Capt. Robert Green, Capt. James Pendleton, John Washburn. CC - Samuel & Joseph Scott. Surv. Richard Young.

ALEXANDER BAXTER, assignee of John Baptist Teer/Tier; 16 Sept. 1766 - 29 Oct. 1767; 182 a. surv<sup>d</sup> for M<sup>r</sup> Richard Young in 1767 & ungranted land known as Hopper's Cabin or Spring, near Indian R. on S. side

JOHN ROBERTS, JUN<sup>R</sup>, 1 Mar. 1747 - 4 Mar. 1750; 500 a. in Guordvine Fork, Allan's Run, brs. of Beaverdam Run on Gyant Castle Mt.; adj. William Duncan, M<sup>r</sup> Francis Slaughter. CC - William & Rawleigh Duncan. Surv. Philip Clayton. (On verso of survey - Deed Deld to Colo Slaughter ye 25 May 1760.)

JOHN ROBERTS, the elder, of Orange; 27 Feb. 1747 - 23 Aug. 1748; 510 a. on side of Hat Mt., including Rich Mt. on brs. of Allan's Run in the Gourd Vine Fork; adj. in wart<sup>t</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Fairfax, Esq<sup>r</sup> & David Kinkade, adj. in survey Martin Hardin. CC - Motley Allan & George Roberts. Surv. William Green.

Tract formerly granted to Francis Slaughter who relinquished the waste & ungranted land to Roberts. 8 July 1754 - Jno Roberts desired survey made for Alexand<sup>r</sup> & Dan<sup>l</sup> Campbell, Merch<sup>ts</sup> at Fallmouth.

JOHN ROBERTS, JUN<sup>R</sup> & WILLIAM ROBERTS, 20 May 1748 - 4 Jan. 1749; surplus within bounds of a pat. to Malcolm McKenzie 20 May 1735 & bequeathed by will to Jno Roberts, Jun<sup>r</sup> & W<sup>m</sup> Roberts; 1,555 a. on Cannon R. Battle Run & Battle Mt.; adj. George Fairfax, Esq<sup>r</sup>, James Cannon (now W<sup>m</sup> Duncan's), M<sup>r</sup> Gabriel Jones, McKenzie, John Roberts, Sen<sup>r</sup>. CC - Philip Par Edmondson & John Chisum. Surv. William Green.

Michael Laller's (?) house drawn on plat across Cannon R. 29 June 1778 - John Roberts the Elder made oath before Robt Eastham, Jun<sup>r</sup>, JP, "that his son John Roberts died without a will & that his Son William Roberts is the right heir at Law to the Land" & "sd John Roberts Obtained a Warrant in the sd County in the name of his two sons John & William Roberts" & he desired that William Roberts have deed for same.

**MAJR WILLIAM ROBERTS**, 3 Sept. 1779 - 9 Oct. 1779; 400 a. at foot of the Red Oak Mt. & on Thornton's R. commonly called the Cannon R.; land granted to John Barragall 30 June 1778 who d. intestate & without any known heir. CC - Jno Cannon & Elisha Cheek. Surv. George Hume.

1779 - Before John Slaughter, Deposition of John McKinny - he heard John Barricle say that Mary Kiggins now wife of Francis Cheek should have all that he had at his Death. 1779 - Deposition of Charles Mazingo said (same as above) & Barricle wanted Mary Kiggins in consideration of her services to her grandmother & himself to have what he had. 1 Sept. 1779 - Deposition of John Strother, Gent<sup>l</sup> "...in conversation with John Barricle at His House I observed mary Kiggin The grand Daughter of the Wife of John Barricle to Be Then a Yong Woman." Barricle lived in my Neighborhood & Mary had lived many years with the Barricles, they being old & Infirm. I asked Barricle why he did not let Her go to see the Neighbors & he sd The Girl was Bear of Cloaths at That time. But when she marries I will Give her part of my Land and set her up & at my Death all That I have Except a small Legicy such as a Cow or something Like that to some of Tho<sup>s</sup> Burruss's family But which I Cannot Till... Sometime after Mary Kiggan married I heard S<sup>d</sup> Barricle say he would Give her nothing. (Signed) John Slaughter.

WILLIAM ROEBUCK, 27 Mar. 1775 - 20 May 1775; 302 a. near White Oak Run
