# Last Will and Testament

OF

WILLIAM L. BECK

I, WILLIAM L. BECK, a resident of Arlington, Virginia, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, and I do hereby revoke any and all other Wills and Codicils previously made by me.

## ARTICLE I

### Family Identification

I am a widower and I have two children, WILLIAM R. BECK and ANNE B. HANSEN. Both have reached majority.

## ARTICLE II

### Payment of Debts and Other Charges

My Co-Executors shall pay or provide for the payment of my funeral and burial expenses, the costs of administration of my estate, and all of my legally enforceable debts, secured and unsecured; however, my Co-Executors may cause any debt to be carried, renewed or refinanced from time to time upon such terms and with such security for its repayment as my Co-Executors may deem advisable, taking into consideration the best interests of the beneficiaries hereunder. I also direct that any personal property received by my children be shipped to them at the expense of the estate.

## ARTICLE III

### Payment of Taxes

My Co-Executors shall pay or provide for the payment of all estate, inheritance and similar taxes (except generation-skipping transfer taxes) payable by reason of my death, including taxes on assets not passing under this Will and interest on these taxes. All such taxes and interest shall be paid as a cost of administering my

estate without apportionment among the beneficiaries.

#### ARTICLE IV

##### Distribution of Tangible Personal Property

A. I request that my family honor any written memorandum that I may leave regarding disposition of any particular items of my tangible personal property.

B. I give all of the undesignated tangible personal property to my children in approximately equal shares. Any of said property that is not desired by my children or, in the discretion of my Co-Executors, is not appropriate for distribution in kind, may be sold by my Co-Executors and the proceeds shall be added to my residuary estate to be disposed of as hereinafter provided.

#### ARTICLE V

##### Distribution of Remainder of Estate

A. I give all the rest of my real and personal property to my two children in equal shares. If either child predeceases me, his/her share shall go to his/her surviving children, per stirpes.

B. If either of my children predeceases me leaving no surviving child, then my deceased child's share shall go to the child that survives me.

#### ARTICLE VI

##### Interest Vesting in Certain Beneficiaries

If any interest in my estate vests in a beneficiary under age Twenty-five, my Executor shall select a Trustee who shall hold the interest in trust. My Trustee may pay to or for the benefit of the beneficiary as much of the net income or principal of the trust as my Trustee may deem appropriate for the beneficiary's support, health and education. When the beneficiary reaches age Twenty-five, my Trustee shall distribute the trust assets to the beneficiary. If the beneficiary dies before reaching that age, my Trustee shall distribute the trust assets to the beneficiary's estate. No Trustee who serves hereunder shall be required to furnish any security on any bond that may be required by law for the faithful performance of the Trustee's duties. My Trustee shall be entitled to reasonable compensation and shall have the same powers as my Executor.

ARTICLE VII

Executor

A. I nominate my son, WILLIAM R. BECK, and my daughter, ANNE B. HANSEN, as Co-Executors of this my Last Will and Testament. In the event that either should predecease me, or fail to qualify, or having qualified, should die, resign or become incapacitated, then I nominate and appoint the survivor as Executor of this my Last Will and Testament.

No Executor who serves hereunder shall be required to furnish any security on any bond required by law for the faithful performance of the Executor's duties.

ARTICLE VIII

Compensation of Fiduciaries

For rendering services as the Co-Executors, my Co-Executors shall receive reasonable compensation as provided by law.

ARTICLE IX

Fiduciary Powers

A. I give to my Co-Executors full power and discretion in the management and control of my estate, including the right and power to lease real estate for such term or terms as my Co-Executors deems proper and to sell, convey, transfer or otherwise dispose of all or any portion of any real or personal property at any time held hereunder which my Co-Executors may deem necessary or advisable for the advantageous administration of my estate. I also authorize my Co-Executors (including any substitute or successor Executor) in the exercise of a reasonable discretion with respect to all property, real and personal, at any time forming part of my estate, to exercise any or all of the powers set forth at the date of the execution of this Will in Virginia Code Section 64.1-57, these provisions being hereby incorporated into this Will by reference as fully as if copies herein verbatim.

ARTICLE X

Miscellaneous

A. A person who is a beneficiary under this Will shall be considered to have predeceased me unless he or she survives me by at least thirty (30) days.

B. To the extent permitted by law, the principal and income of my estate shall not be liable for the debts of any beneficiary or subject to alienation or anticipation by a beneficiary, except as otherwise provided.

C. Any real property that passes under this Will shall pass to the beneficiaries as each beneficiary's sole and separate equitable estate and the spouse of a beneficiary, if any, shall have no interest in such real property.

D. The word "Co-Executors" means "Executor" or "Executrix" where appropriate.

E. If it should be required by law that there be a resident fiduciary with respect to any appointment made herein of a non-resident fiduciary, then such non-resident fiduciary shall select a resident fiduciary to serve with or for the non-resident fiduciary with the resident so selected to serve without security on any bond that may be required by law.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the said WILLIAM L. BECK, hereto set my hand and seal to this Last Will and Testament this 17 day of OCTOBER, 1995.




